## ARRIVAL TO ANTWERP

### ARRIVAL AT ANTWERP CENTRAL STATION

All delegations arriving in Antwerp will arrive either by bus or train to Antwerp Central Station, one of the most beautiful train stations in the world (!), where you will be welcomed to Antwerp by our volunteers on Saturday 10 & Sunday 11 September (based on the transport details we received). They will guide you to your accommodation (within walking distance), where you will be assisted in checking into your room.



### ARRIVAL AT BRUSSELS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (BRU)

FISU Mind Sports volunteers will be waiting for you at the Airport to welcome you to Belgium. Upon arrival you will receive a ticket for the Brussels Airport – Antwerp shuttle bus. Shuttles are available every 2 hours (at 4-6-8-10-12-14-16-18-20-22-0h). The shuttle takes about 45' to Antwerp Central Station, where you will be welcomed again by our volunteers.

### ARRIVAL AT BRUSSELS SOUTH AIRPORT CHARLEROI (CRL)

## ACCREDITATION

Location: University of Antwerp – Aula Rector Dhanis

Accreditation takes place on Saturday 10 september (18:00-20:15) and Sunday 11 september (12:00-16:00). Specific timing slots have been foreseen for each delegation based upon time of arrival in Antwerp. An overview of these slots will be sent to all participants.

All participants must obtain accreditation approved by the FISU International Control Commission (CIC) and from the Organizing Committee. Heads of Delegations are requested to present passports/identity cards and eligibility forms of the whole delegation.

## GENERAL TECHNICAL MEETING

Location : University of Antwerp – Grauwzusters

The Technical Meeting for both Bridge and Chess will take place on Sunday 11 September at 16h00. Please don't come with the whole team, but it is expected that minimum one representative from both your Chess delegation as your Bridge delegation (if applicable) attend the meeting. The meeting starts with the practical aspects about the event, followed by highlighting of all specific chess- and bridge regulations and procedures. If you have a questions in advance, please send them by email to [wucmindsports2022@uantwerpen.be](mailto:wucmindsports2022@uantwerpen.be) no later than 11 September 12h00 for the OC to prepare. Of course all questions are welcomed during the General Technical Meeting.

### OPENING CEREMONY & WELCOME RECEPTION

Location: University of Antwerp – Aula Rector Dhanis

On Sunday 11 September, the Opening Ceremony starts at 18:45. Please be on time. Doors open at 18:15. Be in time, so you can get to know the other delegations. For each attending nation, one athlete will have the honour of carrying the flag of his/her respective nation on stage. Selection of this athlete is done internally by the delegation.

After the Opening Ceremony we will walk as a group to (recently renovated) Antwerp City Hall, where we are welcomed by the Mayor of Antwerp with a Welcome Reception. It's also possible to see the original Olympic Flag from the Antwerp 1920 Olympics.

### FISU WUC PARTY

Location: Café De Prof – Vekestraat 51

On Thursday, after the Awarding Ceremony for the Bridge Competition, all delegations are invited to the FISU WUC Party, where the first drink is offered by the OC (you'll receive a coupon). As the Chess competition continues on Friday, but only in the afternoon, we hope all participants join.

### CLOSING CEREMONY

Location: University of Antwerp – Aula Rector Dhanis

On Saturday 17 September, the Closing Ceremony starts at 16h15, immediately after the Awarding Ceremony for the Chess Competition. Again one athlete will have the honour of carrying his/her nation's flag.

### HEAD OF DELEGATION RECEPTION

Location: University of Antwerp – Agora

After the Closing Ceremony, all Heads of Delegation are invited to the HoD reception (1-3 persons per delegation).



## PRACTICAL INFORMATION

### EVENT CENTER : HOF VAN LIERE

The WUC Mind Sports will take place in the 16<sup>th</sup>-century Hof van Liere, located at the heart of the University of Antwerp's City Campus. It used to be the house of the Antwerp Mayor, and was later owned by the Jesuit order. After ownership transferred to the University, in 2009 it was reopened as one of the University's Congress locations.

Address: Prinsstraat 13B – 2000 Antwerp.

The Team Info Desk is located on the ground floor. The Chess competition will take place on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor will host the bridge competition, as well as the coffee break room, where all participants can go for a coffee or other drink during the day

### TEAM INFO POINT

The Team Info Point is open during the competitions for all your questions.

## COMMUNICATION DURING THE EVENT

For each delegation a *WhatsApp* group is created with team responsible(s) and the Team Info Point, before arrival in Antwerp. Use the group for your questions related to Antwerp or the FISU WUC Mind Sports when you're not at the Team Info Desk. The OC will also distribute practical information about the event through this group.

## ACCOMMODATION

All participating delegations are staying in 3 different accommodations in Antwerp (Ibis Hotel Kievit, Century Hotel and The ASH), with all members of the same delegation sleeping in the same hotel. All are walking distance from Antwerp Central Station. The overnight stays include breakfast. Athletes are accommodated in single, twin- or three bedded rooms, with members of the same gender of their own delegation. Officials are accommodated in single or twin rooms. Rooming list per delegation will be communicated to each delegation separately.

## TRANSPORTATION

All event locations are within walking distance from each other. From all accommodations, there will be a guided walk to the venue organized in the morning (see program for times) and the evening. For participants staying in Ibis Hotel Kievit and Century Hotel, a transport pass is provided to facilitate access to the venue and the city center for those not wanting to walk more than 1km. Our volunteers will guide you through the metro system. If you can find your own way to the event venue, you can choose to go on your own.

Before departure from Antwerp, we will request the public transport passes to be handed back to the OC if not completely used.

## MEALS

Breakfasts are served in the hotel. A breakfast schedule might apply in your accommodation. Please try to respect this schedule to allow for smooth departure to the competition venue.

During the event days (11-17 September) lunches and meals are served in the University Restaurant Komida (100m from the competition venue). Lunch includes a hot meal (each day different option); dinner includes the typical Belgian "Smos": a large sandwich with vegetables and meat/cheese vegetarian options. Each meal includes a drink and unlimited drinking water. For meal times: check the official program (please respect the times). You will receive a meal voucher upon arriving in the restaurant with your Accreditation Card.

Teams arriving earlier (10 September) or leave later (18 September) will be informed about their meal locations.

## EVENT CATERING

A coffee break area is set up at the venue during competitions. Also in all competition rooms a water buffet is available, with water bottles. For ecological reasons, we try to keep the usage down, so please use all water.

## WIFI

First of all, all accommodations have wifi, check for login at the reception. The City of Antwerp also offers free Wifi in certain locations. Check <https://www.visitantwerpen.be/en/good-to-know/wifi> for all locations in the city with free wifi.

Of course, at all event locations within the University of Antwerp, wifi is also available through a personal "UAntwerp-Guest" login. You'll receive a personal login code during Accreditation. This code is valid during the entire event, but for one device only. If you lose your code, or want to connect an extra device, you can get an extra code at the Team Info Desk. You can also use the "eduroam" network.

## BELGIUM

- Currency: Euro – you can exchange your currency for Euro's at the airport upon arrival, or in an Antwerp exchange office (Western Union, Central Station Change Center, ...). If needed, contact the OC for assistance.
- Electricity: plug type C or E.
- Weather in September: the 2022 summer heat wave is over. Maximum temperatures might drop below 20° during the day next week. Bring a sweater for the colder moments. Some rain might be expected.

## COVID-19

All Covid measures have been lifted in Belgium. In hospitals, doctor's offices and pharmacies, a mouth mask is still mandatory. # COMPETITION

## RULES AND ENTRY

The following regulations will apply to the 2022 FISU World University Championships Mind Sports:

- FISU World University Championships Regulations
- Most recent FIDE regulations (bridge)
- Most recent WBF regulations (bridge)

All FISU regulations about eligibility, balance of registration fees on arrival, etc. will apply.

Only competitors, who satisfy the following conditions may take part in a FISU World University Championship in 2022:

- Athletes must be a national of the country they represent;
- Athletes must be at least 18 and less than 25 years of age on January 1st in the year of the event; for 2022, athletes must be born between the 01/01/1997 and the 31/12/2004;



- Athletes must be students who are currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognised by the appropriate national academic authority of their country;
- Athletes must be former students of the institutions mentioned above, who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event.

## CHESS

FISU WUC Mind Sports 2022 Specific terms:

- Classical : 9 rounds – 90'+30"
- Blitz : 9 rounds 3'+2"
- An overview of specific tournament regulations will be available at the General Technical Meeting on Sunday 11 September 2022.

General Terms FISU Chess:

- The tournament will be organised in accordance with the most recent technical regulations of the "Fédération internationale des échecs" (FIDE). In any dispute, the English text shall be regarded as authoritative.
- The programme and duration of competitions are fixed by FISU in agreement with the Organising Committee and the ITC WUC. The programme of competitions shall last a minimum of six days and includes the following events:
  - one men's tournament (9 rounds): classical and one men's Blitz tournament;
  - one women's tournament (9 rounds): classical and one women's Blitz tournament;
  - Two teams classifications shall be carried out jointly for men and women in classical games and in Blitz games.
- Each country is authorised to enter a maximum of thirteen persons: eight competitors and three officials. Each country may enter a maximum of eight competitors: a maximum of five men and three women, or five women and three men, or four women and four men.
- Only countries with three competitors or more, of whom at least one man and one woman, shall be taken into account for team classification.
- Only participants of classical games can register for the Blitz games.
- At the General Technical Meeting, the Head of Delegation or his/her representative shall confirm and sign the official list of competitors accredited by the CIC.
- Individual classification shall be based on the total of points scored during the game. In case of a tie, the winner shall be determined according to the FIDE rules and the tournament rules applicable to the concerned Chess Championship.

- Team classification shall be based on the total of points scored in the individual tournament and on the three best scores of at least one man and one woman from the same country. If the number of men is equal or more than 1.5 times the number of women, team classification shall be based on the best results of two men and one woman. Similarly, if the number of women is equal or more than 1.5 times the number of men, team classification shall be based on the best results of two women and one man.
- In the event of a tie, the winning team shall be determined according to the FIDE rules.

## BRIDGE

FISU WUC Mind Sports 2022 Specific terms:

- The tournament will consist of a round robin format of 15 rounds.
- Each round is 16 boards. Allocated playing time: 120'/round + 10' break
- An overview of specific tournament regulations will be available at the General Technical Meeting on Sunday 11 September 2022.

General Terms FISU Bridge:

- The competitions will be organised in accordance with the most recent technical rules of the World Bridge Federation (WBF) unless otherwise stated. In case of disagreement in the interpretation of these rules, the English text shall be regarded as authoritative.
- The programme and duration of competitions are fixed by FISU in agreement with the Organising Committee and the ITC WUC.
- The competitions last four days.
- Each country is authorised to present three teams of six persons.
- Each country can register a delegation composed of a maximum of eighteen competitors and five officials.
- The event shall be disputed by teams of four players in a round robin competition.
- At least one match per round shall be broadcast via BBO.

## LIVE GAMES & RESULTS

**CHES:** All chess games will be played on electronic boards and broadcast through most common websites ([www.chess24.com](http://www.chess24.com), ...).

**BRIDGE:** All results can be followed live through the event website. One game per round will be broadcast live through BBO.

Tournament links will be distributed at the start of the event, through our website as well as internal communication to all delegations.

#### AWARDING CEREMONIES

To all medallists, we ask to be at the right location 10' before the start of the Ceremony to be briefed about the procedure.

##### **Bridge**

Location Awarding Ceremony Bridge: University of Antwerp - Grauwzusters

The Awarding Ceremony Bridge starts Thursday 15 September at 20:00, after dinner. To all bridge participants, we request to be on time for the Ceremony. There will be one medal ceremony.

##### **Chess**

Location Awarding Ceremony Chess: University of Antwerp – Aula Rector Dhanis, followed by Closing Ceremony.

The Awarding Ceremony Chess will take place on Saturday 17 September at 15:00. There will be 6 medal ceremonies, for each of the official competitions (Women, Men, Women Blitz, Men Blitz, Team, Team Blitz)

#### DOPING

Doping is strictly forbidden. Controls will be organized by NADO Vlaanderen and may be carried out at any time during the championship in accordance with the procedures described in the WADA International Standard of Testing and Investigations (ISTI). The FISU-, WBF, and FIDE- anti-doping rules and the World Anti-Doping Code apply.

When selected for doping control, the athlete must strictly follow the instructions of the controllers. They must bring official identification (with photo) to the doping test area. The athlete should also present the personal Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if applicable.

#### CLOTHING

National Team Uniform from the participant's respective nation is not mandatory, but strongly encouraged.

#### INSURANCE

The OC declines any liability that might occur through participation in the 2022 FISU World University Championship Mind Sports. Each person participates at her/his own risk and is responsible for her/his own insurance coverage (illness and accident).
